<b>Description</b>		
<p>Hello,</p> <p>when accessing to extplorer by webdav the files and directory are displayed in upper case and with the full path.</p> <p>it happen only with some linux client :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- nemo ( cinnamon desktop )</li><li>- thunar ( xfce desktop )</li></ul> <p>it does not happen with cadaver CLI tools, nor with windows explorer ( i haven't tested unity/ubuntu nor gnome/nautilus )</p> <p>i guess this behavior shows because theses tools are displaying the displayname property instead of the path .</p> <p>however, it seems quite easy to fix :</p> <pre>in libraries/HTTP/WebDAV/Server/Filesystem.php replace ( line 215 )  \$info["props"][] = \$this-&gt;mkprop("displayname", strtoupper(\$path));</pre> <p>by</p> <pre>\$info["props"][] = \$this-&gt;mkprop("displayname", basename(\$path));</pre> <p>and folders and files are properly displayed. i have tested ok with :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- windows explorer</li><li>- thunar</li><li>- nemo</li><li>- cadaver</li><li>- macOS finder</li></ul> <p>Best regards</p>
